

**Where Art
Thou?
Genesis 3:9**



God asked of Adam and Eve this question. Why? Before they ate of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, they did not know sin (or Evil). But once they ate of the fruit, they knew evil and separation from God. Before they had walked with God. Now they covered and hid behind a tree. BEFORE they

gain advantage of others. There is no one that is without sin, regardless of how his life may appear. But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags...There is none that doeth good. The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men...They are all together become filthy. There is none that doeth good, no, not one!

God's Remedy

All of man's efforts to attain God's righteousness are Vain! Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but NOT OF MY SPIRIT, that they may add sin to sin (like Adam and Eve). For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement (covering) for your souls. Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them. You will NEVER stand before God in your Own Righteousness. God promised a deliverer in Genesis 3:15. Messiah would bruise Satan's head and Satan would bruise Messiah's heel. And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but NOT FOR HIMSELF...Behold my ser-

basked in the glory of God's counsel, NOW they made flimsy aprons to hide their shame and fled from his presence. It only took this **one transgression** to sense their unworthiness before a thrice-holy GOD! This question was asked that they might acknowledge their sin and get a covering from God.

If you were to make an accounting of your daily sins, what would it be? One, Two, Four, Eight, Ten, Fifty, One Hundred SINS? Consider: God said in Deuteronomy 27:26, "**CURSED be he that confirmeth not all the words of this law to do them, And all the people shall say, AMEN!**" There are 613 commandments in the Torah (first 5 books). We must confirm and obey ALL the commandments or we are CURSED! Hell will be our home! Ponder the 10 Commandments. (1) **Thou shalt have no other gods before me.** Do we have anything in our life which has priority over God? How about our home, car, vacation home, boat, girl (boy) friend, mutual funds, television, alcohol, spouse, possession, idea, or desire which keeps us from God. (2) **Honour thy father and mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.** This commandment is not condi-

vant...he hath no form or comeliness...that we should desire him...Sure he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows...He was wounded for OUR TRANSGRESSIONS, he was bruised for our iniquities...with HIS stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. God has provided a Lamb for our sin. We must acknowledge that The Lamb died for our personal sins. We must repent of our way. **Let the wicked for his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts...** We must accept the completed atonement Messiah made on our behalf. **Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling. KISS the SON, lest he be angry and YE PERISH from the way, when HIS WRATH is kindled but a little. BLESSED are all they that put their TRUST IN HIM.**

If you reject YOUR Messiah promised by Jehovah, you will perish in Hell, FOREVER, but ALL WHO will TRUST his blood covering will be BLESSED! **For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, "The LORD, said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, until I make thy foes thy footstool.**

tional on how you think your parents treat you. YOU are to HONOUR them! (3) **Thou shalt not commit adultery.** God prohibits this act, but goes farther. This act starts in the mind, long before it culminates in the physical act. Ezekiel 8:12, **Son of man, hast thou seen what the ancients of the house of Israel do in the dark, every man in the chambers of his imagery? For they say, The LORD seeth us not; the LORD hath forsaken the earth.** Are you a "dirty old man"? The sin of King David began with his eyes! (4) **Thou shalt not steal.** This sin includes taking anything that does not belong to you, i.e. stealing through false returns, stealing time from the boss who is paying you, not being productive for the boss, and not returning that which belongs to someone else. Do you buy or sell deceptively. **It is naught, it is naught, saith the buyer: but when he is gone his way, then he boasteth!** (5) **Neither shalt thou desire thy neighbour's wife, neither shalt thou covet thy neighbour's house, his field, or his manservant, or his maidservant, his ox or his ass, or anything that is thy neighbour's.** The sin is coveting! Desiring something that belongs to someone else is covetousness. Do you look for opportunities to

Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ."

He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?
